2024 Flow Variance Termination**

Dear Acting Secretary Reese:

On June 27, 2024, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) issued an order approving Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) temporary flow variance request for the Potter Valley Hydroelectric Project, FERC No. 77. The order requires PG&E to notify FERC that the variance has ended no later than 15 days after Lake Pillsbury's storage level exceeds 36,000 acre-feet. On October 1, 2024, Lake Pillsbury's storage level exceeded 36,000 acre-feet, terminating the flow variance.
